INFORMATION

DRY SEASON – OCTOBER-JANUARY

These months are much cooler where the temperature is around 73°F. There is very little rain and humidity during these months which makes it a great time to visit the beaches. Things to pack while visiting during the dry season include sandals, shorts, capris, teeshirts, and tanks. Don't pack too much warm clothing, you will be fine with just 1-2 pairs of pants and long-sleeved shirts or light sweaters. Also, don't forget a hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen.

Temperatures average between 73°F to 82°F (23°C to 28°C)

FAQ ABOUT TRAVEL IN GHANA

• 1. Is it safe to visit Ghana?

Compared to other African countries, Ghana is a very safe. Just stick with the group and follow directions and you will be fine.

• 2.Do I need a visa?

3.Do I need vaccinations?

Common vaccinations required for a trip to Ghana are hepatitis A, hepatitis B, rabies and typhoid, diphtheria, polio, measles, and yellow fever. It is best to consult with a doctor for vaccinations that you will need specific to this trip

• 4.Can I drink tap water?

No, you can only drink boiled or bottled water we will provide you.

• 5.ls English spoken in Ghana?

Yes, Ghana's two official languages are English and Twi

• 6.What currency is used in Ghana?

The Ghanian Cedi is used as currency although, many businesses will also take USD. We will help with the dollar exchange at the local bank

• 7.How much money should I bring?

Ghana is a fairly expensive country. On a low budget, expect to pay around \$50/day. For Midrange to high budgets, \$100-\$250 a day is the norm.

• 8.Where are the best places to see wildlife?

In Ghana, there is an abundance of wildlife. Mostly in the volta region and northern parts.

9. Are we going on a special safari?

Safaris are typically an additional \$1,000 for an all-inclusive 30 hr experience. To keep the trip budget-friendly, we focus on smaller, more accessible local attractions. However, if you're interested in a grand safari adventure, we'd be happy to help arrange this for you at your request.

• 10. What else is there to do in Ghana besides safari?

Hike Mount Afadjato, relax on Ghana's beautiful coastal sandy beaches, and try out the local cuisine!
